Guide for Property Owners of Short-term Rental Properties

Short-term renters staying at a property in the Municipality of Dysart et al need to use a "One-Time Landfill Pass" to enter any Dysart landfill.

Property owners should provide a One-Time Landfill Pass to short-term renters to make their stay that much more easy, but short-term renters in Dysart can purchase them too.

One-Time Landfill Passes are \$5.00 each and allow short-term renters to dispose of:

- Up to three (3) bags of garbage in clear bags
- Unlimited Recycling sorted into Containers and Papers

A charge of \$2.00 per additional bag of garbage will be applied. A charge of \$2.00 per dark/opaque bag of garbage will be applied.

One-Time Landfill Passes can be purchased at the Haliburton Landfill, Harcourt Landfill, Kennisis Lake Landfill, and West Guilford Landfill, and the Haliburton Welcome Centre. These sites accept payment by debit card, Visa, MasterCard, and American Express.

One-Time Landfill Passes have an expiry date. Please purchase accordingly. There are NO refunds on unused One-Time Landfill Passes.

Agreement

As the property owner of a short-term rental property, I agree to:

- Purchase One-Time Landfill Passes and provide them to my short-term renters
- Require my short-term renters to use clear bags for garbage
- Require my short-term renters to sort recycling into Containers and Papers
- Provide my short-term renters with landfill hours of operation
- Display garbage, Recycling for Containers, and Recycling for Papers posters above the corresponding bins on my property (visit www.dysartetal.ca/shorttermrenter for recycling and garbage posters)

Waste Management Guide for Short-term Renters



We do not have curbside pick up in Dysart et al. You need to take your garbage and recycling to one of our five landfill locations.



Short-term renters staying at a property in Dysart need to use a **One-Time Landfill Pass** to enter any Dysart landfill.



Up to three (3) bags of garbage in clear bags are permitted per One-Time Landfill Pass. Transparent garbage bags are mandatory.



Recycling is mandatory. You must sort recycling into Containers and Papers. You can drop off unlimited recycling.

Purchase your One-Time Landfill Pass for \$5.00 each at Haliburton, Harcourt, Kennisis Lake, and West Guilford Landfills, or Haliburton Welcome Centre during regular operating hours



One-Time Landfill Passes have an expiry date. Please purchase accordingly. There are NO refunds on unused One-Time Landfill Passes.

Waste Management

Recycling for Containers

Rinse all containers and ensure they are clean of liquids or food



Food & Beverage Cartons

Plastic bottles, tubs, containers (caps can be left on)

Plastic plant pots and trays (no soil)

Glass bottles and jars

Metal beverage cans, metal food cans

Aluminum foil and trays

Cardboard canisters

Styrofoam (food and drink only)

Plastic shopping bags (clean, dry, empty)

Recycling for Papers



Boxboard

Newspapers

Magazines & Catalogues

Paper (office, mixed, writing)

Envelopes (includes ones with windows)

Corrugated cardboard (flatten)

Paper beverage cups (plastic lids go in Recycling for Containers)

Brown paper bags

Paper egg cartons, paper take-out trays

Toilet paper rolls, Paper towel rolls

Garbage

Must be placed in clear garbage bags



Plastic Ziploc bags, other plastic film & bags

Plastic food pouches

Cookie, chip, bar, snack bags and wrappers

Plastic straws, plastic cutlery

Disposable gloves, masks, sanitizing wipes

Food waste (consider composting)

Broken ceramics

Paper towel, facial tissues

Styrofoam block and peanuts

Diapers (consider reusable)

Cotton balls, pads, swabs

Fats, cooking oil, grease (never pour down sink)
